## Guest Parking in Discovery Lot


Once you arrive, you can purchase parking by downloading the ParkMobile app. The zone number for the Discovery Lot is 4903.

### **From East or West along I-66 and points North:**

From I-495, take exit 49A to I-66 West. From I-66, take Exit 44, Route 234 South (Prince William Parkway). Travel approximately four miles and turn left at University Boulevard. The Science and Technology Campus will be on your left. Turn left on Cannon Creek Lane to enter campus.

### **From I-95 and Eastern Prince William County:**

From I-95, take Exit 152B (Route 234 – North, to Manassas). Travel approximately 19 miles on Route 234 North; it becomes Prince William Parkway. One half mile past the Route 28-Manassas interchange, turn right on University Boulevard. The Science and Technology Campus is on the left. Turn left on Cannon Creek Lane to enter campus.

## NOTES

- ❖ All eastbound lanes of I-66 inside the Beltway are restricted to HOV-3 from 5:30 A.M. to 9:30 A.M. and all westbound lanes of I-66 inside the Beltway are restricted to HOV-3 from 3:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M. You will need an E-Z Pass Flex set to HOV mode to travel toll-free. The lanes are free with no tolling or HOV requirement at all other times, including federal holidays.
